

Proposed Fetcham Railway Station



In the early 1930s it was proposed to build a railway station in Fetcham Village on the left hand side of the present bridge in Cobham Road with a platform on the Reading Room side going towards Waterloo. The plan also proposed Allotment Gardens, National Playing Fields and sites for a Public House, Petrol Station and shops.

Alas, the plan never happened and the land eventually went into building houses estates, Monks Green, Hilley Field Lane and Meadow Lane

There was an advertisement for the Monks Green estate c1935 which stated that "the station would be opened shortly"
