
Leatherhead & District Local History Society Potted Histories No 77 Shamrock Cottage - Pound Farm - Fetcham

The name Pound Farm originated from what was originally the pound mentioned above. The farmhouse, believed to be an 'improved' cottage, dated from the late seventeenth century, but all traces disappeared in 1950 after the building of Pound Crescent.
