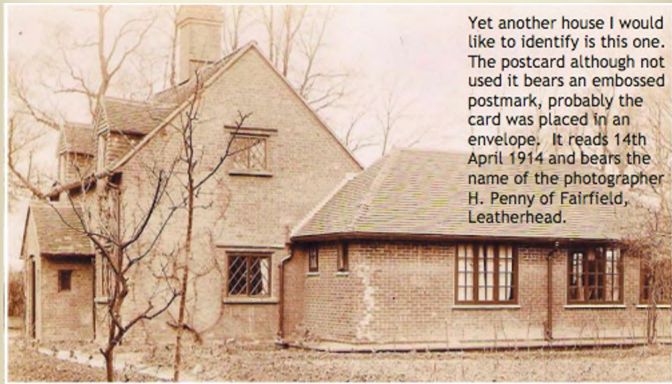
Potted Histories No 81

Where in Leatherhead...?



For many years now I have compiled Potted Histories on Places, People and Companies, and I hope they have given readers of the Ashted & Leatherhead Local much pleasure. Now it is time for readers to help me in identifying some buildings in Leatherhead.

The house on the left is a postcard, postmarked Leatherhead and dated 28th August 1913. It is addressed to a Miss Avery in Ulverston, Lancs. and just signed M.L.S.



Yet another house I would like to identify is this one. The postcard although not used it bears an embossed postmark, probably the card was placed in an envelope. It reads 14th April 1914 and bears the name of the photographer H. Penny of Fairfield, Leatherhead.
